EDITORIAL

CHAMROUSSE, AT THE ORIGIN OF SKIING If I was told about the mountain spirit...

Perched 1500m above the Alps capital, the high territory, a real panoramic view point at the heart of mountain ranges and large valleys has been the setting of epic stories and legendary moments.

Histories of mountain of course, but histories of men who paved the way, pioneers in a world to explore, a new land to live, in harmony with a strong but sometimes rough nature, but always exceptional.

Some key dates, ground-breaking for most of them:

A first chalet built since 1865, the place of the first ski trials in France in 1878, 140 years this year!

1st ski ascent in winter in 1891, 1st alpine ski area in 1893, 1st Club Alpin Français (French Alpine club) aimed at skiing in 1911, 1st mountain architecture of the 50's, an exceptional and avant-garde cable-car since 1952, 1st live broadcasting of the Olympics in 1968 and place for all the alpine event during Grenoble Olympics, resort awarded for its environmental actions... Today, the resort is named as an example for the renovation project Chamrousse 2020-2030.

We are about to blow many candles this year: 140 years of the French ski, 50 years of the Grenoble Winter Olympics, 130 years of the mountain troops,... Strong foundations like the rock of Belledonne mountain range, to imagine the future and live emotions respecting our living environment.

Chamrousse appeared to the outside world in 1964, when Grenoble was chosen to host the Olympic Games. But it is only in 1968 that the resort became mythical, thanks to Jean-Claude Killy and his three gold medals.

To refresh the minds, Chamrousse will organize events from January, 23rd to March, 10th, with a Legends Race as opening ceremony. This race will gather medalists and sportsmen of 1968 for a parallel slalom on the Aiguille slope, and be followed by a light and sound show about the history of skiing.

Monumental shows are planned all season, once or twice a week. These repeating events will draw an increasing audience and highlight all the events on this period:

- Fan zone during Pyeongchang Olympics from February, 9th to 25th 2018
- School Winter Games from February, 5th to 10th
- Torchlight descent world record attempt with Grenoble-Alpes university (UGA),
- Rossignol On Tour,
- Early Spring Break with Dahu des Neiges and NRJ Extravadance

Other dates, already scheduled, are going to expend this olympic spirit:

- Winter Challenge of Mountain Troops: March,14th and 15th 2018
- Nordic Ski Cross French Championships: March, 17th
- Handisport French Championships from March 23rd to 25th 2018

SKITOURING ACCESS

Ski touring is getting famous. Chamrousse now offers a marked and safe route as well as a second departure on seal skins from Casserousse, leading to Pourettes lakes and Robert lakes.

1) Access to off-piste departure:

- Level: confirmed
- Distance: 1.1 km Vertical drop: 400 metres
- Access: Casserousse parking area

Opening times*: every day from 8.30am to 6pm (watch out: winch grooming from 6pm to 8.30am) New chairlift in Casserousse since 2017.

*subject to snow conditions

2) Ski touring route up to La Croix

- Level: accessible to everyone
- Distance: about 4km Vertical drop: 510 metres
- Access: Bachat Bouloud bridge in Chamrousse 1750

Opening times*: every day 24h/24h - « ski touring » pass valid for two one-way trips (Casserousse chairlift, La Croix gondola or Lacs Robert chairlift) to get to Les Vans. Price: 9€.

SNOW PRODUCTION

Twice as much snow from the top to the bottom of the slopes



Chamrousse has doubled its snow production with 78 snowmakers and 22,5 hectares more of snow-covered slopes (blue areas on the image), that is 48,5 hectares to guarantee ski-in ski-out.

The snowpark is a place for freestylers whereas the Family Park is open to everyone. Sight and sound modules invite families and children to come and play.



MINI-DOMAINE

An area adapted to beginners

It allows to discover skiing at a low cost in areas with adapted lifts and slopes. The mini-domaine ski pass in Chamrousse is valid on the 3 parts of the resort (1650, 1700 et 1750) with 4 ski tows (Aiguille, Croisette, Lauze and Totem) and 1 chairlift to ski peacefully on green slopes. Moreover, it only costs 14€.



NORDIC AREA



One of the most beautiful nordic ski areas of the Alps, but not only...

Apart from the timeless atmosphere, the Arselle preserved area offers many activities. You can leave on snowshoeing tracks on your own or with a guide.

SLEDGING PARK



A sleging slope with a lift

All day, sledgers will have the pleasure to ride « almost » endlessly on a 2.1km dedicated slope with 315m vertical drop, banked turns and moguls. No need to drag your sledge!

The slope is reserved to sledging with a dedicated lift and is open at day time but also night time on Saturday (depending on snow conditions)

IGLOO VILLAGE

The High North Adventure

In a frozen atmosphere, discover a nordic accommodation around a warm meal. A real igloo village is set at the summit of the resort for the 3rd year. Come and spend a night on an ice bed and taste a fondue. Many options possible, including a sunset snowshoe outing to whet your appetite and enjoy the exceptional panorama.

ALPINE SKI AREA

Expected opening of the ski area:

From SATURDAY, DECEMBER, 2ND TO MONDAY, APRIL, 22ND 2018 (depending on snow conditions)

The resort of Chamrousse is located at the end of the Belledonne mountains, 30km away from Grenoble. It extends on four levels: Chamrousse 1400, Chamrousse 1650, Chamrousse 1750 and Chamrousse 1700, linked by the ski slopes and the forest tracks. 2250 meters high, the Croix de Chamrousse is the highest point.

The resort was built in the forest, offering an outstanding overview of the Grenoble valley:

East: Grandes Rousses and Oisans

West: Vercors plateau

South: Taillefer and Mount Aiguille

North: Chartreuse



Accommodation

1 igloo village, 2 hotels including a 1 hotel**, 3 real estate agencies, 4 residences (including 2 residences***), 1 B&B, 1 youth hostel, 3 group accommodations and 2 camper van areas.

Initiatic Park for beginner (green on the map)


- Mini Kilomètre Lancé (KL): mini slope for timed speed skiing (permanent timing)
- « Beginner » jump area: ground movements like whoops

Kids Park - intermediate (blue)

- Mini boardercross: obstacles course with moguls and banked turns
- « Intermediate » jump area: moguls, boxes and rails
- Parallel slalom: two slaloms for speed
- Family Park: series of fun modules for the entire family

Snowpark - expert (red)

- Shred: series of modules (boxes, rails...) where confirmed skier scan rotate on a series of elements
- « Expert » jump area: moguls, boxes and rails
- Boarder cross: ski area composed of moguls, banked turns and kicks (designed by Marion Josserand, bronze medalist at Vancouver Olympics)





NORDIC SKI AREA

Arselle plateau: natural wooded area at 1600m of altitude with an outstanding view of the Taillefer. You will also find pedestrian and snowshoeing tracks on the nordic area.






SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT - FLOCON VERT

Chamrousse, the first resort in Isère to get Flocon Vert!

Flocon Vert, is a labelthat guarantees the sustainable commitment of mountain resorts. This label is developed by the association Mountain Riders to give mountain lovers a clear vision of model tourist sites. Choosing a Flocon vert destination for our holidays is supporting a responsible tourism!



Chamrousse resort has applied to Flocon Vert label in 2016. It was assessed in December 2016 and the labelling board granted Chamrousse the label in January 2017.

For a year, the tourism, the resort players have worked to comply with Flocon vert specification and its 31 compulsory requirements, together with Mountain Riders, bearing the label. This work has been carried out in cooperation with the different players of the resort, but also the inhabitants, employees via a participating process with a Sustainable Development group gathering regularly, open to all of those who want to move forward.

If Chamrousse complies with the compulsory requirements, the resort is aware that the process implies a follow-up and was able to identify the axes of progress.

The resort's last emblematic actions:




PROJET CHAMROUSSE 2020-2030
